Ngatikahu ki Whangaroa – update on negotiations and release of claimant funding

Purpose

1. This report updates you on negotiations with the Ngatikahu ki Whangaroa Trust (Nktw Trust) and seeks your approvals for the release of the next \$50,000 instalment of claimant funding to the Trust, to assist with achieving the milestone "Signed Agreement in Principle".



Release of next instalment of funding

- 10. On 8 November 2006, you and the Minister of Finance jointly approved a claimant funding upper limit increase of \$358,000 for NKKW negotiations, based on a reassessment of eligibility under the modified claimant funding policy approved by Cabinet in April 2006. The increase brings the total upper limit of claimant funding to \$708,000. To date, \$273,000 has been released to the NKKW Trust, which means that there is now \$435,000 in claimant funding available for the remainder of the NKKW negotiations.
- 11. As indicated above NKKW anticipated that they would have achieved an Agreement in Principle in November 2006, which would have enabled them to apply for another instalment of \$50,000. NKKW have requested the release of the next \$50,000 instalment of claimant funding to assist them to complete the Agreement in Principle phase, more specifically so they can retain the use of premises in Whangaroa.
- 12. The last instalment of funding of \$50,000 was released 7 months ago in December 2006 to enable the NKKW Trust to meet the "Signed Agreement in Principle" milestone. In assessing the NKKW Trust's request for a further instalment of claimant funding, officials have considered whether the funding provided to date has been spent on reasonable negotiations costs, and whether progress has been made in negotiations.
- 13. The NKKW Trust has provided officials with an itemised spreadsheet specifying what the last instalment of claimant funding has been spent on. Officials are satisfied, based on this information, that the previous claimant funding instalment of \$50,000 (released in December 2006) has been spent on reasonable negotiations costs.

- The NKKW Trust has borne the cost of reaching agreement with Kaitangata representatives on the final components of the regress package. Officials 14. consider that if an advance of \$50,000 is not paid it will affect the Crown's relationship with the NKKW-Trust-and may jeopardise their willingness to complete Agreement in Principle negotiations.
- Wes therefore, recommend, that you approve the early release, of the next∗ instalment of \$50,000 funding to the NKKW Trust associated with the milestone "Signed Agreement in Principle. The table in Attachment 1 outlines the allocation of the recently increased NKKW claimant funding against milestones in the negotiations process, demonstrates how funding has been spent to date, and shows the amount now proposed for release.
- Should you approve the \$50,000 advance payment, \$10,000 is available for the "Negotiations to Agreement in Principle" milestone, and \$40,000 will be an 16. advance from the "Negotiations to Deed of Settlement" milestone. There will be \$250,000 remaining funding to assist the NKKW Trust to reach the "Signed Deed of Settlement" milestone.

 - note that officials consider that if an advance of \$50,000 is not paid that it affect the Crown's relationship with the NKKW Trust and may jeopardise their willingness to complete Agreement in Principle ňegotiations;

approve the early release of the next instalment of \$50,000 claimant YES funding to the NKKW Trust, associated with the milestone "Signed Agreement in Principle" and in advance of the milestone "Signed Deed of Settlement".
